Talking Points for Orientation to Your Lab Space

Behavior Expectations (dress code, food/bev use, etc)
Locations of equipment and supplies
How to use common equipment (bed, monitor, IV pump)
How to verbally interact with "patient" & how to receive responses
Is there a medical record, if so, how is it accessed
Deviations from "real"How to:
Contact the provider
Retrieve assessment unavailable from simulator
Work with drain bags, IVs, etc
Perform skills safely (ie betadine, oral meds, IV labels, sharps)
Emergency Exits/Processes for unexpected weather or hazardous situations
